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EXPERIENCES

BEACHES

With 57km of unmatched stretches of pristine coastline, you'll be spoilt for choice with the many award-winning white sandy swimming beaches, secluded coves and surfing hot spots.

LOCAL TIPS

- Look out for local lifeguards at popular beaches for advice on daily swimming conditions and for safety, always swim between the red and yellow flags.
- Accessibility beach mats for wheelchairs are available at a number of popular beach locations - just ask the local surf lifesaving club.







CAFÉS

From dusk until dawn, choose from a wide range of cafés, bakehouses and bistros to experience some of the best coffee in Australia, paired with meals to make your mouth water.

- Grab brunch to-go and visit one of the many seaside vantage points to catch a glimpse of the beautiful morning sunrise.
- Check out local coffee haunts including James Street in Burleigh, the Oracle Broadbeach or the Nobby Beach precinct.

THEME PARKS

Suitable for both the young and the young at heart, create lasting memories at Australia's biggest and best collection of adventurefilled theme parks.

LOCAL TIPS

- Explore Dreamworld, Movie World, WhiteWater World, Wet'n'Wild, Sea World and the US newcomer, Topgolf, where rides, animal encounters and experiences are plentiful and the fun is endless.
- Pre-book your own cabana at the water parks the perfect place to relax or base yourself for a day amongst the water slides.





Immerse yourself in the oldest culture in the world with the Gold Coast's resident Indigenous custodians, the Yugambeh people.

- Take a guided walk in a nature reserve, visit a local cultural centre or watch an inspiring traditional performance.
- Daily cultural tours are available from the Jellurgal Aboriginal Cultural Centre in Burleigh Heads.

SURFING

Surf the iconic coastal beach breaks from Snapper Rocks and Duranbah in the South, all the way up to Main Beach and Stradbroke Island in the North.

LOCAL TIPS

- Rise with the sun for an early morning paddle amongst seasoned local surfers, and even whale and dolphin marine life in the summer.
- Learn to surf with year-round lessons available for all ages and abilities.





BREWERIES & WINERIES

The Gold Coast and its Hinterland are home to some of the finest and most celebrated wineries, distilleries and modern breweries.

- Spend a leisurely afternoon or evening on a tour or at your own pace.
- Join a backstage tour at one of the iconic breweries or make your own gin with a head distiller at one of the Gold Coast's craft distilleries.

- Pack a picnic and hike trails to the Natural Bridge or Best of All Lookout.

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
STAND-UP PADDLEBOARD

- For a more relaxed vibe, check out Miami Marketta's bars and live music alongside over 26 food stalls.


FESTIVALS & EVENTS

CRUISE THE WATERWAYS


